Every day of the year, an event, a devotion, a shrine of Our Blessed Mother is commemorated. During Mary's month, some of these will be highlighted.

Mary, Help of Christians (today's feast)

When the foundation for Don Bosco's church in Turin, "Mary, Help of Christians" was laid, he told the contractor: "I want to pay you at once. I don't know if it will be much, but this is all I have." He took out his little purse and emptied its contents into the hand of the contractor, who was expecting a handful of gold coins. His jaw dropped in dismay when he saw in his hand eight pennies. "Don't be alarmed," Don Bosco quickly added, "the Madonna will see to the payment of her church. I am just the instrument, the cashier." The contractor later testified, "The Church was paid for to the last cent." Don Bosco commissioned an artist, Lorenzone, to paint the central image. He envisioned it: "The Most Holy Mary on high, among choruses of angels. Then choruses of prophets, virgins and confessors. On the ground, the emblems of Mary's great victories and the peoples of the world raising their hands towards her asking for help." The painter made him see that such a picture could only be housed in a *square and a huge church*. The saint resigned himself to reducing the scale. Lorenzone hired the highest hall and started work. After three years, the great painting was in place. Don Bosco described it: "The Virgin standing in a sea of light and majesty, surrounded by a horde of angels paying homage to their Queen. With her right hand, she holds the sceptre, the symbol of her power, and with the left, the Child with His arms open wide, offering His grace and mercy to those appealing to the majesty of His Mother. Around and below them are the Apostles and the Evangelists in a state of sweet ecstasy. Almost exclaiming: 'Regina Apostolorum, ora pro nobis!' they contemplate the Holy Virgin in amazement. At the bottom of the picture, there is the city of Turin with the sanctuary of Valdocco close up and Superga (the church) in the background. The picture's greatest value is the religious ideal that makes a pious impression on whoever admires it."
